&

HELP SAVE THE WORLD

Community scrapbands is about resource awareness and **re-use**
(**BEATS recycling!**).

The aim is that by having rich experiences and fun while making music from "**junk**", we may learn to see the material *not* as waste but as a valuable **resource**. This shift in perspective will hopefully make us think twice before putting something out as trash/recycling.

Many of the elements of music education are transmitted by using "**scrap**" as instruments, thereby preserving the Stradivarius violin, Bechstein grand piano and rusty triangle for occasions when nothing else will do. This **reduces** demand for new materials.

Thus there is a net saving of the worlds resources.
